HOW TO USE





Place end in unfiltered water (a glass, water bottle, river, or puddle!), and suck the resulting clean water up through the mouthpiece.

When finished, blow the remaining water out of the LifeStraw® to clean the filter.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What does the LifeStraw® filter?

It removes 99.9999% of waterborne bacteria (>LOG 6 reduction), and 99.9% of waterborne protozoan parasites (>LOG 3 reduction). It also removes turbidity in water.

What doesn't the LifeStraw® filter?

It does not filter out heavy metals, chemicals or viruses. It does not filter salt water (eg: it will not desalinate water).

How much water does it filter?

264 gallons (1000 liters).

Who designed the LifeStraw®?

The Switzerland based public health company, Vestergaard-Frandsen.

What type of filter does it use?

Hollow fiber membrane.

Does the LifeStraw® use Iodine?

No, the LifeStraw does not use Iodine, or Iodinated resin, meaning it is safe for those with thyroid concerns.

Where is the LifeStraw® manufactured?

The LifeStraw is manufactured in South Korea.

How do I know when the LifeStraw® has filtered the 1000 liters and is used up?

The LifeStraw® will stop drawing water through the filter after 1000 liters of use.

How much does a LifeStraw® cost?

The list price is \$24.95 per LifeStraw
